The Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar, invites E-Bids in Two Bid System (i.e. Technical and Financial Bid) from eligible Manufacturers only through E-procurement solution portal of AIIMS Bhubaneswar (<https://www.tenderwizard.com/AIIMSBBBSR>) on mutually agreed terms and conditions and satisfactory performance for Rate Contract for Supply of Disposables and Consumables (Surgical Dressing) at AIIMS Bhubaneswar and supply of items as per the Specifications. The Rate Contract Shall be for a period of 1(One) year extendable for another one year on mutually agreeable conditions.

The Bidder is expected to examine all Instructions, Terms and Conditions, Forms, and Specifications in the bidding document. The bid should be complete and in the prescribed format as per the requirement of the bid document. The bid should not be conditional. Failure to furnish all information required by the bidding document or submission of a bid not responsive to the bidding documents in all respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in rejection of the bid.

Section-II
INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

2.1 The Bidder is expected to examine all instructions section wise. The bid should be precise, complete and in the prescribed format as per the requirement of the bid document. The bid should not be conditional. Failure to furnish all information required by the bidding document or submission of a bid not responsive to the bidding documents in every respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in rejection of the bid.

2.2 Language of Bid: The Bid prepared by the Bidder and all correspondence and documents relating to the Bid exchanged by the Bidder and Tender Inviting Authority, shall be in English language. Supporting documents and printed literature furnished by the Bidder may be written in another language provided that they are accompanied by an authenticated accurate translation of the relevant passages in the English Language in which case, for the purpose of interpretation of the Bid, the English translation shall prevail.

2.3 EMD: Bidders need to deposit the EMD amount as defined at **Annexure-V** in the form of FDR/Bank Guarantee in favour of "AIIMS Bhubaneswar" in a sealed envelope on or before the Date of Submission of Bid in the Tender Box kept in the **Tender box kept in the Mini Board Room, Directors Office, 1st Floor, Admin Building, AIIMS Bhubaneswar-751019(Odisha)** and its legible scanned copy must be uploaded in the E-Tendering Solution.

AIIMS Bhubaneswar will not pay any interest on EMD amount to bidder. The EMD of the successful bidder shall be returned after the receipt of Performance Security Deposit and in case of unsuccessful bidders the same will be returned after award of the contract. The EMD of a Bidder will be forfeited, if a bidder withdraws bid after opening of Technical Bid/ misrepresents facts or submit fabricated/forged/tampered/altered/manipulated documents.

The FDR or BG submitted as EMD are subject to verification from the issuing bank before its acceptance. If at any time the said instrument is found to be fake or not as a valid banking instrument, the bidder submitting such instrument shall be black listed and shall be debarred from participating in future tenders of the Institute. *The EMD BG should cover the liability period from last date of bid submission and should be valid for a minimum period of 180 days and claim date should be two months from expiry of BG validity period.*

2.4 Exemption: Following categories of Sellers shall however, be exempted from furnishing Bid Security:

2.4.1 **Firms registered with NSIC** (for sale of Medical Equipment/Consumables/disposables/apparatus) are exempted from submission of EMD (subject to the financial limits indicated in the NSIC certificate). Govt. of India/State Government departments/Undertakings are also exempted from EMD. However, the respective departments/ firms have to submit the relevant certificate (NSIC etc.) and financial limit to avail this exemption.

2.4.2 **Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs)** who are holding valid Udyam Registration and are manufacturer of the offered Product or Service and give specific confirmation to this effect at the time of bid submission and claim EMD exemption and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration website of Ministry of MSME and also through supporting document uploaded during bidding process and validated

by the Buyer. Under MSE category, only manufacturers for goods and Service Providers for Services are eligible for exemption from EMD. Traders are excluded from the purview of this Policy.

- 2.4.3 **Start-ups** as recognized by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), holding valid Start-up Recognition Certificate which is to be uploaded while bidding and claiming EMD exemption and to be validated by the Buyer. Bidder to ensure that turnover for any of the financial years has not exceeded beyond limits prescribed in the certificate / Start Up scheme of DPIIT

2.5 Clarification of bidding documents:

All the representation should reach in the designated e-mail IDs on or before **02-09-2024** at **5.00 PM** to have a clear understanding on schedule of requirements, specifications and on terms & conditions of the tender. After due deliberation, changes if any may be incorporated in the tender document and will be uploaded on our official website as “Corrigendum”. Therefore, bidders may submit their bid accordingly as per changes if any incorporated after clarification. No press advertisement will be made for corrigendum(s).

2.5.1 Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India/MSEs):

- 2.5.2 **Preference to Make in India products:** Purchase preference to Make in India products and MSE will be guided as per GoI orders/guidelines issued time to time. As per Make in India guidelines issued by Department of Pharmaceuticals dtd.18th May 2018, the minimum local content for medical disposables and consumables should be 50%. The bidder must have to upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Bids with false declarations regarding Local contents shall be rejected as unresponsive, in addition to punitive actions under the MII orders and for violating the

Code of Integrity as per the Tender Document. If a Bidder is claiming exemption (as obtained from relevant authorities) from meeting the stipulated local content on account of manufacturing the product in India under a license from a foreign manufacturer with the precise phasing of increase in local content, he must provide proof thereof.

2.5.3 Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

2.6 Amendments in Bidding Documents:

(i) At any time prior to the dead line for submission of Bid, the Tender Inviting Authority may, for any reason, modify the bid document by amendment and publish it Central Public Procurement Portal (<https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>).

(ii) At any time till 7 (seven) days before the deadline for submission of bids, the AIIMS Bhubaneswar may, for any reason, whether at own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, modify the bidding document through amendment. All amendments will be uploaded on the website regularly. AIIMS, BBSR shall not be responsible to notify the amendments to individual bidders. All amendments by the AIIMS, BBSR till 7 (seven) days before the deadline for submission of bids, shall be binding on the participatory bidders

2.7 Withdrawal of Bid: The Bidder can withdraw its Bid before the closure date and time of receipt of the Bid. The system shall not allow any withdrawal after expiry of closure time of the Bid.

Section-III

TWO BID SYSTEM AND CONDITIONS

- 3.1 Technical Bid:** All required documents are to be submitted/ uploaded online. However, **the following documents in Original are to be sent to Sr. Procurement-cum Store Officer, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar-751019, separately in a sealed envelope super scripted as : “e-Tender Ref. No.: AIIMS/BBSR/STORE-78/209/2024/07, dtd-23-08-2024 and Subject: Rate Contract for Supply of Disposables and Consumables at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar”.** The sealed enveloped should reach on or before last date & time for submission of e-Tender i.e., before the due date of submission of online bidding.
- a. EMD in ORIGINAL (Bid Security)
 - b. Undertaking for acceptance of all Terms & Conditions (Annexure-I).
 - c. Notarized affidavit on Indian Non-judicial stamp paper of ₹10/-as per Annexure-II.
 - d. List of items along with Item codes for which firm has quoted without mentioning price Annexure-XIII.
 - e. **Original Label** of all quoted items and Literature/Brochure/Catalogue of all quoted items.
- 3.2 Financial Bid:** The Financial Bid to be submitted online as per prescribed format in Section IX. The Financial Bid of bidders, who qualify in Technical Bid Evaluation, will be opened thereafter.
- 3.2.1** The Rates are to be quoted in the given format “Section-IX”.
- 3.2.2** All quoted rates should be inclusive of freight, packing, forwarding & insurance & Labour charges and also percentage of GST etc.
- 3.2.3** The rates should be quoted in Indian Rupees in figure as well as in words only.
- 3.2.4** If a firm quotes NIL charges/consideration, the bid shall be treated as unresponsive and will not be considered.
- 3.2.5** The price in the Financial Bid to be quoted as per the formulation unit only as mentioned in the list of items.
- 3.2.6** The Tender Evaluation Committee may also verify the veracity of claims in respect of known performance of the item(s) offered, experience and reputation of the bidder in the field, the financial solvency etc.
- 3.2.7** An offer submitted in vague/ambiguous financial terms and the like, shall be termed as non-responsive and shall summarily be rejected.
- 3.2.5 L-1 will be decided on the lowest price including GST of each product** for which the bidder is quoting. GST has to be mentioned clearly in percentage for each product. Item wise evaluation will be done for determining lowest quoted price for each of the Items. If discrepancy observed in quoted GST among bidders for a particular item, then decision will be taken as per GST confirmation only.

Section-IV

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 4.1** Bidder shall only be a manufacturer having valid **own/third party/Loan manufacturing license** with product registration certificate issued by the Drugs Controller General of India.

- 4.2 The manufacturer shall have a valid manufacturing license or duly acknowledged renewal application with old license issued by the State Licensing Authority/Central Licensing Approving Authority (wherever applicable). The firm is required to submit the renewal License copy immediately on receipt and suspension/cancellation of License if any must be informed immediately. **Bidders claiming for Third party/Loan manufacturing License** must submit **approval from the state/central drug Licensing authority** for such an agreement.
- 4.3 In case of importer, it should have a valid import license and **product registration certificate** issued by the **Drugs Controller General of India**. For the item(s) which are being imported, the participating Bidder will submit valid Import License issued by appropriate authority in India.
- 4.4 Manufacturer should have valid **manufacturing License** issued by Central Drug Standard Control Organization (**CDSCO**). The list of items approved in the Licence/Certificate should also be enclosed.
- 4.5 Bidder should have valid **ISO 13485/WHO cGMP/other relevant QMS** Certification as applicable. The list of items approved in the Licence/Certificate should also be enclosed.
- 4.6 As per **Make in India** guidelines issued by Department of Pharmaceuticals dtd.18th May 2018, the minimum local content for medical disposables and consumables should be **50%**. The bidder must have to upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made.
- 4.7 The Bidder should have **experience** (across at least 3 states of India) in supplying quoted item/Similar item as per tender specification to the State or Central Government or Government Hospitals/Corporate Hospitals/PSU Hospitals in India/UN agencies/Authorized agency of the State/Central Govt./PSU as a manufacturer during the **last 2(two)years**. **Bidder to submit Purchase Order copies and relevant Invoice copies for the same**. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications.
- 4.8 The Bidders should have at least **02 (Two) years market standing** for the quoted item(s) as per tender specification (In Annexure-III/Market standing certificate issued by the licensing authority to establish the 2 years' market standing of for the quoted item(s) as per tender specification. In case of newly introduced item(s), the participating Bidder will submit valid Certificate from appropriate Central/State Govt. agency in support of the claim and valid Licence from the concerned Licensing Authority.
- 4.9 **"Non-Conviction certificate"** issued by the licensing authority that the manufacturers/importer have not been convicted under the provision of D&C Act 1940 and Rules thereof by any court of law in contravention to the above Act & Rules.
- 4.10 **Financial Standing Criteria:** The Manufacturer shall have a **minimum turnover of Rs.15 Crore (Rupees Fifteen Crore)** or more in each year during last (3) three financial years in India. The proof of Turnover is to be furnished in the Annexure-VI certified by the Chartered accountant and supported by audited Financial statement. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications.

- 4.11** The participating bidder/manufacturer must have in house testing facilities and quality control facility validated by Govt./statutory agency. Bidder should submit **In-house test report / test report** from Government Approved NABL Laboratory. For items not regulated under Medical Devices Rule 2017, bidder should submit BIS / ISO /IEC / CE/ USFDA Certificate for ascertaining quality of the quoted items.
- 4.14** Qualified Bidders are required to arrange a demonstration of the quoted products, if required by technical evaluation committee (TEC). Failure to arrange for a demonstration on the given date may lead to cancellation of the bid or depends upon recommendation of TEC. Cost of organizing such demonstration shall be borne by the bidder. The sample submitted should be tagged individually with a label in the given format.

the particulars on the tag should be furnished in indelible ink securely fastened to the sample. In case of sterile items, the label should be fastened in a manner such that sterility will not be lost. The bidder should submit on the prescribed date the samples along with list of sample items in the given format at Annexure-XII.

The Tender Inviting Authority's contractual right to inspect, test and, if necessary, reject the goods after the goods' arrival at the final destination shall have no bearing of the fact that the goods have previously been inspected and cleared by Tender Inviting Authority's during sample testing as mentioned above.

Bidder must note that the sample submitted by the concerned L-1 Bidder will be retained by AIIMS, BBSR till the completion of Contract.

Section-VI

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- 6.1 Validity of Tender:** The validity of the Bid Tender Document shall be for **180(One hundred and eighty)** days from the date of last date of submission of the bid.
- 6.2** **No deviation is accepted. Bidders may send representation to consider the deviation/suggestion in specification on or before the last date of receipt of representation. Changes if any, will be issued as Final Corrigendum/addendum. No further deviation will be accepted for evaluation in Technical stage or any further.** Qualified Bidders are required to arrange a demonstration of the quoted products, if required by technical evaluation committee (TEC). Failure to arrange for a demonstration on the given date may lead to cancellation of the bid or depends upon recommendation of TEC. Cost of organizing such demonstration shall be borne by the bidder.
- 6.3 E-Tenders should be quoted only by the Original/actual manufacturer/authorised Importer.** The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bid and AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, hereinafter referred as “Tender Inviting Authority”, will in no case be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Bidding process.
- 6.4** The supply of Disposables and Consumables/products/Articles should be of required quality/ standard as per specification, having useful life as specified in this tender and supply should be made in good condition to the Central stores, AIIMS, BBSR by the bidder at their own cost i.e., F.O.R.at AIIMS Bhubaneswar. Any spurious/ to be expired/ sub-standard item has to be replaced by the bidder without any fail at their own cost.
- The Bidder must quote items which are either marked ISI/European CE/USFDA. For such items, the bidder will be eligible if it possesses and submit valid ISI/European CE/USFDA Certificate/Licence issued by Bureau of Indian Standards/European CE/USFDA for the last three preceding years. Equivalent Indian standards like BIS/CDSCO/AERB shall also be accepted wherever/whichever applicable/available.
- If the supplier, having been notified, fails to respond to take action to replace the sub-standard items within 3 (three) days on a 24 x 7 x 365 basis, the purchaser may proceed to take such remedial action(s)as deemed fit by the purchaser, at the risk and expense of the supplier and without prejudice to other contractual rights and remedies, which the purchaser may have against the supplier.
- 6.5 Fall Clause:** If at any time during the execution of the contract, the Manufacturers reduces the sale price or sells or offers to sell such stores, as are covered under the contract, to any person/organization including the purchaser or any department of Central Government or any department of AIIMS Bhubaneswar/PSUs at a price lower than the price chargeable under the contract during the Current Financial Year, he shall forthwith notify AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, The necessary difference amount about such reduction or sale or offer of sale to the purchaser and the price payable under the contract for the stores supplied after the date of coming into force of such reduction or sale or offer of sale shall stand correspondingly reduced and deposited to AIIMS Bhubaneswar by the Bidder or AIIMS Bhubaneswar will deduct from the pending bills/Performance

Security Deposit to recover the loss to the Government. The Rate Contract holder shall furnish the following certificate to the concerned Paying Authority along with each bill for payment of supplies made: *“I/We certify that there has been no reduction in sale price of the goods of description identical to the goods supplied under this contract and such goods have not been offered/sold by me/us to any person /organisation including the purchaser or any department of Central Government or any as the case may be upto the date of bill/ the date of completion of supplies against all supply orders placed during the currency of the Rate contract at a price lower than the price charged under the contract.”*

- 6.6** The Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar has full authority to take into account the performance of eligible Manufacturers and they should submit a latest performance certificate from any other Govt. Hospitals/Institutions/PSUs to testify the proper dealing & performance and Supply of Items. Any form of tampered document shall be out rightly rejected and shall be viewed seriously.
- 6.7** **Purchase Order(s)** will be placed from time to time as and when required during the currency of the contract in which exact quantities required on each occasion together with the date of delivery shall be specified.
- 6.7.1** **No guarantee can be given as to the minimum quantity** which will be drawn against this contract but the rate contract holder firm will have to supply quantity as may be ordered during the currency of the contract.
- 6.7.2** Purchase Order(s) against the contract will be accepted as long as these reach the Rate Contract holder/firm on or before last date of the currency of the contract. Purchase Orders received during the closing days should be complied with in due course, in accordance with the contract, even though in some cases owing to contract having expired, supplies are to be executed after the expiry of the last date of contract.
- 6.8** **Delivery of supplies/Stores:** Delivery of stores shall be F.O.R to Central Store, AIIMS Bhubaneswar. The AIIMS Bhubaneswar is not liable for payments on account of Freight/Taxes/ allied expenditures/loading-unloading, which are to be quoted inclusively by the suppliers. **The manufacturer can have only one authorized agency/authorized stockist for all/part of their quoted items throughout the Contract in Bhubaneswar. Frequent changes of authorization are highly discouraged. Change of authorization will be acceptable only in justified cases AND supply/delivery is not disrupted in any way, subject to approval of the Competent Authority. Request for change of authorization after the expiry of delivery will not be entertained. It** will be the sole responsibility of the participating manufacturer to ensure the supply once the PO is issued. The registered office of authorized agency/ stockist/distributor/dealer should be existing within the radius of 50(Fifty) km distance from AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.
- 6.8.1** The firm will be bound to supply the ordered items preferably **within 30 days of issuance of purchase order.** Extension shall not be allowed in ordinary course, except in cases of any natural calamities, All India Transportation strike (with sufficient proof). Any other genuine case of request of extension may be considered/allowed (subject to approval from Competent Authority) provided that the request is received within 10-15 days of receipt/acceptance of Purchase Order or before the due date whichever is earliest. Thereafter, suitable action as deemed fit (Refer term No.-6.8.7), will be initiated. If the items are imported one, necessary documentary proof along with a request letter from the Importer/dealer thereof may be submitted for consideration of 90 days Delivery Period for such items.

- 6.8.2** The successful Bidder along with the copy of the Invoice shall submit the copy of the Standard Quality Certificate of analysis wherever applicable from their own laboratory/NABL Accredited Laboratory/Government approved Laboratory as applicable with necessary protocols for every batch of items supplied to the Central Stores & Hospital Pharmacy, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar at the time of supply. The successful bidder has to submit all copies of the Test Reports to Central Pharmacy, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar for future reference within 7 days of delivery.
- 6.8.3** The supplier shall supply the materials along with copy of Invoice, Purchase Order, Test Report, Delivery Challan and other relevant documents at the Central Stores, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar during working days (Monday to Saturday excluding Holidays) and working hours (i.e.09:15AM to 05:15PM). Where more than one batch of item is supplied under one Invoice, the quantities of each batch supplied shall be clearly specified. The date of manufacture, the date of expiry of each shall be specified. The quantity supplied shall be in terms of the Units mentioned in the Tender Document/ PO. *The suppliers are cautioned that the variation in the description of product in the Invoice/analysis report and actual supplies will be considered as improper invoicing and will be dealt accordingly.*
- 6.8.4** If the supplier fails to deliver the goods on or before the stipulated date, then **Liquidated damage (LD)** charges at the rate of 0.5% per week or part there of exceeding 3 days from the stipulated date. (Excluding the date of issue of purchase Order/acceptance letter and date of delivery) shall be levied subject to maximum of 10% of the total order value. Purchaser may also resort to termination of the Purchase Order & even contract at any time after expiry of the allowable period for supply of the materials. The competent authority of the institute may also cancel the supply. In such a case, bid security of the supplier shall stand forfeited.
- 6.8.5** Part/Partial supply will not be accepted. However, in special circumstances, part supply may be accepted as per the institutional requirement with prior written permission and total delivery is to be completed within stipulated delivery period. The Part billing is strictly prohibited.
- 6.8.6** In case the quality of goods supplied are not in conformity with the standard given in tender and as per the samples supplied or the supplies are found defective at any stage these goods shall immediately will be taken back by the supplier and will be replaced with the tender quality goods, without any delay. **Ground Rent** at the rate of 1% of the cost of un-cleared/rejected material per week or part thereof, with maximum ceiling of 10% of value of the un-cleared/rejected material shall be applied from after 14 days of the issue of Rejection Notice. Ground rent shall be calculated from the day just next to the date of expiry of the period of removal of rejected items as mentioned on rejection intimation letter issued by the Store Section of AIIMS Bhubaneswar. If the rejected items are not lifted after lapse of 10 weeks and if it is found that the firm has not taken any action for lifting of rejected goods, then the goods may be confiscated and disposed off as per disposal procedure in vogue after sending a notice and giving 30 day's-time to the firm. When the firm fails to pay the applicable ground rent within the prescribed period, AIIMS Bhubaneswar is entitled to recover the ground rent due and all incidental expenses from EMD/PSD/Bill if any.
- 6.8.7 Risk Purchase & Penalty:** In case the bidder on whom the purchase order has been placed, fails to make supplies within the delivery schedule and the purchaser has to resort risk purchase, the purchaser (AIIMS,

Bhubaneswar) may recover from the bidder the difference between the cost calculated on the basis of risk purchase price and that calculated on the basis of rates quoted by bidder. In addition, Liquidated damage will also be recovered for the items defaulted; calculated from the date of PO issued till the supply of the item(s) through risk purchase. The amount will be recovered from any of his subsequent/pending bills or Security Deposit. Black listing of the firm may be initiated depending upon the circumstances of the default/merit of the case.

- 6.8.8** The quantity for supply will be as per the requirement of user departments and is subject to increase/decrease at the discretion of the competent authority of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. The payment would be made for actual supply made as per purchase order.
- 6.8.9** The selected Manufacturers shall also provide the name and mobile number of a key person, who can be contacted at any time, even beyond the office hours and on holidays. The person should be capable of taking orders and making arrangement for supply of the desired items even at short notice to AIIMS Bhubaneswar. The selected manufacturer should submit two working e-mail IDs for all official correspondence which will be registered in the vendor directory. Any changes in the Mail IDs must invariably be informed immediately to AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.
- 6.9 Testing of Items:** The AIIMS Bhubaneswar shall be at liberty to undertake regular and random testing of item(s) supplied by the Rate Contract Holder at regular interval to maintain and ensure the quality of item(s) supplied by any Govt. Approved Laboratory. The report of the Govt. Approved Laboratory shall be binding on the Rate Contract Holder firm, If the R/C holder disagrees with the outcome of test result, may approach Appellate Authority for drugs i.e., CDSCO for a fresh test of the sample within three months from the date of communication of the disputed test report to the Rate contract holder firm.
- 6.10** If single item/Batch of item(s) is/are declared NSQ (Not of Standard Quality) under Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO), then the supplier has to take back all the NSQ items/batch immediately and replace the quantity with fresh batch quantity. Recovery will be initiated wherever payment had already been made. Rate contract Holder will be liable to pay damages/compensation (if any) to individual/individuals arising due to consumption of such NSQ declared items and in case of any adverse reaction reported in the Hospital during administration of the item(s). If more than one item/batch of items belonging to a particular firm is declared NSQ within a year, then the firm will immediately be debarred from current and all future rate contracts of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar for a period of three years. This will also lead to forfeiture of Performance Security of the concerned firm.
- 6.11 Payments:** 100% payment shall be released after successful delivery of the ordered goods against the satisfactory inspection report/taking charge report by the User Dept. and only after the submission of the performance security duly confirmed by issuing bank, within to 30 to 45 days.
- 6.11.1** Bills in triplicate for the items supplied by the selected firm(s), should be raised for payment. Payment shall be released after deducting TDS as per Income Tax Rules and any other deductions as per Government rules only after it is ensured that the items/quantity and quality of items supplied are to the entire satisfaction of this office and accepted. If any item is found to be sub-standard, or not of the desired quality at any point

of time of the contract period, the same shall be replaced immediately, for which no extra payment shall be made by AIIMS Bhubaneswar.

- 6.11.2** The bills raised by the selected tendering Manufacturers should have all tax registration numbers printed on bill. The bill shall be signed by the authorized signatory of the firm across a revenue stamp. Validity of the tax registration during the currency of contract shall be the sole responsibility of the tendering eligible Manufacturers. The bill shall be raised indicating permissible taxes separately and the copies of proof of GST or other applicable taxes deposited to Tax Authorities by the firm for recent period, just before the submission of Bills must also be enclosed for reference of AIIMS Bhubaneswar authorities.
- 6.11.3** If the selected Manufacturers fail to deliver the Consumables and Disposables or replace the defected/spurious/expired/ soon to expire items within the stipulated date & time, a penalty on weekly basis for delay @ 0.5% of total order value per week or part thereof exceeding 3 days (date of purchase order and date of delivery being excluded), subject to maximum of 10% of total order value as penalty and the actual cost paid to other sources by the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Bhubaneswar, for the desired Consumables/Disposables for Hospital, shall be deducted from the Manufacturers pending bills or Performance Security.
- 6.12** The tendering Manufacturers shall be bound by the details furnished by him/her to the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS)Bhubaneswar while submitting the tender or at subsequent stage. Upon selection of the tendering Manufacturers, if at any stage, the documents furnished by him/her is found to be false or the quality of the articles are found of poor quality/different specifications, it would be deemed to be a breach of terms of contract, the contract shall be cancelled, legal action as deemed fit will be taken and performance security shall stand forfeited.
- 6.13** The Lowest quoted rate by the selected Manufacturers as approved by the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Bhubaneswar, shall remain valid throughout the period of contract and the request to increase the rates for any or all items, during the currency of contract, shall not be entertained at any stage.
- 6.14** The selected firm(s) shall not be allowed to transfer, assign, pledge or sub-contract its rights and the contract will be valid from the date it is awarded/formalities completed. This office will, however, reserve the right to conduct performance review at any time during the contract period and deficiencies, if any, noticed shall be required to be rectified and compliance reported. This office reserves the right to suo-moto terminate the contract by giving one month's notices at any point of time.
- 6.15** The Life period of any of the item supplied by the successful Bidder/Bidders will have the Minimum of two third of the expiry period remaining on the date of receipts of Items in AIIMS Bhubaneswar. The supplied items having less than two-third expiry period to AIIMS Bhubaneswar shall not be accepted. Loss or premature deterioration due to biological and/or other Factors during life span of Stores against the manufacture's standard warranty/Expiry of such items shall be replaced by the Bidder on free of cost.
- 6.16** The supply contract will be valid from the date of LoA. This office will, however, reserve the right to conduct performance review at any time during the supply contract period and deficiencies, if any, noticed shall be required to be rectified and compliance be reported. This office reserves the right to Suo-moto terminate the supply contract by giving 30 days' notices at any point of time.

- 6.17** Both on large and smallest units (Bottle/Strips/pack) of the Consumables and Disposables, it is mandatory to Print/Sticker/stamp in indelible ink on label/packets/cartons “**AIIMS, BBSR SUPPLY, NOT FOR SALE**” & No Price Should be quoted/printed on the Label. Cases, wherein quoting of price cannot dispensed with, it should be covered in indelible ink at the time of supply at AIIMS Bhubaneswar.
- 6.18 Inspection of supplies:** - Inspection will be done by the duly constituted committee members nominated by Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar and or his authorized representatives in AIIMS Bhubaneswar premises at designated place.
- 6.19** The AIIMS Bhubaneswar shall not be responsible for any financial loss or other damage or injury to any item or person deployed/supplied by the Supplier Agency in the course of their performing the duties to this office in connection with purchase order/supply order for supplying of Stores/Goods/Items at AIIMS Bhubaneswar.
- 6.20 Packaging & marking of supplies:** -The firm shall supply the stores with proper packing and marking for transit so as to be received at destination free from any loss or damage.
- 6.21 Disputes & Arbitration:** -All disputes or differences arising during the execution of the contract shall be resolved by mutual discussion, failing which the matter will be referred to an Arbitrator who will be appointed by the Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar for Arbitration for settlement of disputes in accordance with Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996 or its subsequent amendment, whose decision shall be binding on the contracting parties. All disputes are subject to exclusive jurisdiction of Competent Court and Forum in Bhubaneswar, Odisha, India only.
- 6.22 Law governing the contract and Jurisdiction:** -The contract shall be governed under Indian Contract Act 1872 and instructions thereon from the government of India. The Court of Bhubaneswar shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of or in respect of the contract.
- 6.23 Performance Security Deposit:**-The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Security Deposit of minimum of Rs.1,00,000/-(Rupees One Lakh only) OR an amount proportionate to the value of yearly consumption for number of items selected for award of contract be decided by AIIMS,BBSR as Performance Security Deposit in favour of “AIIMS Bhubaneswar” by way of “Irrevocable Performance Bank Guarantee or Fixed Deposit Receipt” (in favour of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar) from Nationalized/Commercial Bank which is refundable.The performance security shall remain valid for a period of 14 months from the date of contract LoA. Security Deposit is liable to be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or impairs or derogates the bid in any respect.
- 6.24 Parallel Rate Contract/Purchase:** The AIIMS Bhubaneswar reserves the right to place an order for supply of any items mentioned in the Rate Contract at any stage to any other firm(s) without any information to the Rate Contract holder. Purchaser reserves the right to conclude one or more than one rate contract for the same item. AIIMS Bhubaneswar can renegotiate the price with the rate contract holders, even during the validity, if market conditions change significantly or undertake repeat competitive bidding through open/ advertised tenders on the same terms and conditions, including specifications during the validity period of existing valid R/Cs. In such cases, the existing R/C holders can bid, apart from the new eligible bidders, and equal and fair opportunity would be provided. If the prices received are found lower than the

existing Rate Contract prices, new Rate Contracts may be awarded at reduced prices and existing Rate Contracts at higher prices may be short-closed, giving adequate notice if they do not match such reduction in prices under the fall clause.

- 6.25** After due evaluation of the bid(s), Institute will award the contract to the responsive bidder who has quoted the lowest Price in each of the items. Item wise evaluation will be done for determining lowest quoted price in each of the Items except for item in bucket wise as per Clause 3.2.5. The Purchaser will have the option to negotiate the price with the bidders if situation warrants.
- 6.26** **Conditional Bids will be treated as unresponsive and therefore shall be rejected.**
- 6.27** The Institute reserves the right to accept in part or in full or reject any or more Tender/offer without assigning any reasons or cancel the tendering process and reject all Tender at any time prior to award of contract, without accepting any liability, whatsoever.
- 6.27.1** In the event of the claims in the on-line documents are materially missing or of substantial error or unqualified for want of required qualifications, the bid shall be rejected. However, minor/ trivial nature of deviations in the submission of documents may be ignored or may be allowed to be rectified by obtaining required clarification by the Tender Inviting Authority so as to ensure qualification of maximum number of competitive offers to the final round.
- 6.27.2** The Bidder shall be responsible for properly uploading the relevant documents in the e-Tender portal in the specific location and the Tender Inviting Authority shall not be held liable for errors or mistakes done while uploading the on-line Bid.
- 6.27.3** In respect of items where single bid has been received, the same may be re-tendered.
- 6.28** A latest certificate of GST payment should be enclosed.
- 6.29** Any bidder (as defined in paragraph 6 of the Order No. F.No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23.07.2020 issued by Ministry of Finance Department of Expenditure Public Procurement Division) from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority as prescribed in the aforesaid order. Proof of such registration should be enclosed with the bid documents. In case where the manufacturer has submitted the bid, the bids of its authorized dealer will not be considered and EMD will be returned.
- 6.30** **Force Majeure** : If, at any time during the subsistence of this contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reasons of any war or hostility, act of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fire, floods, exception, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockout or act of God (hereinafter referred to as events) provided notice of happening of any such eventuality is given by party to other within 21 days from the date of occurrence thereof. Neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance and deliveries have been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive.
- Further, that if the performance in whole or in part of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event for a period exceeding 60 days, AIIMS, BBSR may, opt to terminate the contract.

6.31 Debarment from bidding:

6.31.1 A bidder shall be debarred if he has been convicted of an offence-

- under the Prevention of Corruption Act,1988 or
- the Indian Penal Code or any other law for the time being in force, for causing any loss of life or property or causing a threat to public health as part of execution of a public procurement contract.

6.31.2 A bidder debarred under sub-section 6.29.1 or any successor of the bidder shall not be eligible to participate in a procurement process of any procuring entity for a period not exceeding three years commencing from the date of debarment. Department of Commerce (DGS&D) will maintain such list which will also be displayed on the website of DGS&D as well as Central Public Procurement Portal.

6.31.3 A procuring entity may debar a bidder or any of its successors, from participating in any procurement process undertaken by it, for a period not exceeding two years, if it determines that the bidder has breached the code of integrity. The Ministry/Department will maintain such list which will also be displayed on their website.

6.31.4 The bidder shall not be debarred unless such bidder has been given a reasonable opportunity to represent against such debarment.

6.32 Code of Integrity:

6.32.1 No official of the bidder shall act in contravention of the codes which includes

(A) prohibition of

- a) making offer, solicitation or acceptance of bribe, reward or gift or any material benefit, either directly or indirectly, in exchange for an unfair advantage in the procurement process or to otherwise influence the procurement process.
- b) any omission, or misrepresentation that may mislead or attempt to mislead so that financial or other benefit may be obtained or an obligation avoided.
- c) any collusion, bid rigging or anti-competitive behaviour that may impair the transparency, fairness and the progress of the procurement process.
- d) Improper use of information provided by the procuring entity to the bidder with an intent to gain unfair advantage in the procurement process or for personal gain.
- e) any financial or business transactions between the bidder and any official of the procuring entity related to tender or execution process of contract; which can affect the decision of the procuring entity directly or indirectly.
- f) any coercion or any threat to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any party or its property to influence the procurement process.
- g) obstruction of any investigation or auditing of a procurement process.
- h) making false declaration or providing false information for participation in a tender process or to secure a contract.

(B) disclosure of conflict of interest.

(C) Disclosure by the bidder of any previous transgressions made in respect of the provisions of sub-clause with any entity in any country during the last three years or of being debarred by any other procuring entity.

6.32.2 The purchaser will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, Fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for the contract in question.

6.33 The Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar, Odisha, India has the full and exclusive right to accept or reject, increase or decrease order quantity, any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons thereof and also to cancel the supply at any time without assigning any reason.
